Admission Requirements – Due by Application Deadline

Apply by March 15th for Summer Entry

- Watch the [Nursing Preview Program](#) video and email attendance confirmation.
- Submit passing scores for the official [TEAS](#) (Test of Essential Academic Skills) test score report.
 - Test is valid for three years from the testing date.
 - Minimum scores for application are a **60% overall** and **69% in reading**.
- GenEd science courses cannot be older than 7 years at application deadline.
- GenEd courses must be in progress or completed with a grade of “C” or higher at application deadline. If the grade is below a “C”, that grade must be replaced before the student is eligible to apply.
- Minimum 2.0 Cumulative GPA (all college coursework).
- Proof of High School graduation (official HS Transcript) or completion of GED.
- Official Transcripts – must submit transcripts from **ALL** schools attended, even if the courses won’t transfer.
 - Foreign transcripts must be evaluated by [World Education Services](#) (WES).
