Admission Requirements - Due by Application Deadline

Apply by February 1 for Summer Entry

- Complete and submit a signed Radiography Observation Form.
 - Students are required to complete 8 hours of job shadowing in a hospital setting with a credentialed radiologic technologist.
 - Observation must be completed between June 15th and December 15th of the application cycle.
 - This form will not be accepted if the job shadowing experience was completed outside of this time frame.
 - A new observation form must be completed for each application cycle.
- Submit passing scores for the ACT® WorkKeys test.
 - Minimum passing scores required are 5 in Applied Math, 3 in Graphic Literacy, and 5 in Workplace Documents.
 - Test is valid for three years from the testing date.
- BIO116, PSY101, ENG101, MAT 114, and the Arts/Humanities Gen Ed must be completed or in progress by application deadline.
- BIO116 & HIM 102 cannot be older than 5 years at application deadline.
- Completed Gen Ed courses must have a grade of "C" or higher at application deadline. If the grade is below a "C", that grade must be replaced before the student is eligible to apply.
- Minimum 2.0 Cumulative GPA (all college coursework).
- Minimum 2.5 Program GPA (Gen Ed course requirements).
- Official Transcripts must submit transcripts from **ALL** schools attended, even if the courses won't transfer.
- Foreign transcripts must be evaluated by World Education Services (WES).
- Submit Supplemental Application for <u>Radiography</u>.
