Admission Requirements - Due by Application Deadline

Apply by January 15 for Summer Entry

- Submit passing scores for the official <u>TEAS</u> (Test of Essential Academic Skills) test score report.
 - Test is valid for three years from the testing date.
 - Minimum scores for application are a 60% overall and 69% in reading.
- GenEd science courses cannot be older than 7 years at application deadline.
- Completed Gen Ed courses must have a grade of "C" or higher at application deadline. If the grade is below a "C", that grade must be replaced before the student is eligible to apply.
- Minimum 2.0 Cumulative GPA (all college coursework).
- Minimum 2.5 Program GPA (Gen Ed course requirements).
- Official Transcripts must submit transcripts from ALL schools attended, even if the courses won't transfer.
 Foreign transcripts must be evaluated by <u>World Education Services</u> (WES).
- Supplemental Application for <u>LPN RN program</u>.
- Active LPN License.
- Satisfactory letter of recommendation from most recent employer.
- Employer verification of at least 6 months full-time employment as an LPN within the past 2 years.
