### **General Education Requirements and Prerequisites**

### **Admission Requirements – Due by Application Deadline**

Apply by January 15 for Summer Entry

- Submit passing scores for the official [TEAS](#) (Test of Essential Academic Skills) test score report.
  - Test is valid for three years from the testing date.
  - Minimum scores for application are a **60% overall** and **69% in reading**.
- GenEd science courses cannot be older than 7 years at application deadline.
- Completed Gen Ed courses must have a grade of “C” or higher at application deadline. If the grade is below a “C”, that grade must be replaced before the student is eligible to apply.
- Minimum 2.0 Cumulative GPA (all college coursework).
- Minimum 2.5 Program GPA (Gen Ed course requirements).
- Official Transcripts – must submit transcripts from **ALL** schools attended, even if the courses won’t transfer.
  - Foreign transcripts must be evaluated by [World Education Services](#) (WES).
- Supplemental Application for the [Paramedic - RN program](#).
- Certification as a Paramedic and National Board of Registry certification (NREMT-P).
- Satisfactory letter of recommendation from most recent employer.
- Employer verification of at least 2 years employment as a Paramedic within the past 5 years.

Apply by January 15 for Summer Entry

Upon successful completion of NUR-195 students will receive an additional 17 credits for the first year of the nursing program
